## We are the seasoning!

Using the metaphors of salt and light, Jesus, in Matthew 5:13-20 teaches that true disciples witness to the gospel in what they say and do, not by merely believing it; something that should never be hidden from those we meet each day.

Jesus states that salt and light have obvious purposes: salt to impart saltiness and light to illuminate. In this parable, salt can change to lose its saltiness. When this happens, it is no longer good for anything.

“Do we cease to be ‘salty’ when we lose an awareness of our poverty of spirit, for instance; or when we cease to engage with communities as merciful peacemakers who thirst for justice? Salt is a substance that transforms the things that it is mixed with”
